

**CAMBUSLANG & DISTRICT SENIORS' LEAGUE
COMPETITION RULES**

2024

1. All players must be 60 years of age or over on the 1st. April of the year in which the League is being played
2. Each team shall consist of 2 Rinks
3. Each game shall consist of 15 Ends with no trial ends. The Rink winning the first end shall count 1 shot only. Visitor's jack
4. The winning rink shall be awarded 2 points for a home win and 3 points for an away win. In the event of a tied game each rink will be awarded 1 point. Shots will be used to determine a League
5. Any player may represent 1 Club only in a season
6. Any Club entering more than 1 team will allow players to represent 1 team only in the competition
7. The league will be played on Wednesdays throughout the season. Play to commence at 10.30am. If Wednesday is unsuitable in any week the Clubs may re-arrange the fixture on another day provided it is played within 2 weeks of the scheduled date.
8. Should any team fail to turn up at the appointed time, and after 30 minutes have elapsed still fail to appear, 4 points and 12 shots will be awarded to the non-defaulting team. In the event of 1 rink failing to appear 2 points and 8 shots will be awarded
9. Any rink which is only able to put forward 3 players shall lose one quarter of their total score
10. Any rink playing an unqualified player will cause the non-defaulting rink to be awarded 2 points and 6 shots
11. Any game terminated because of inclement weather or any other valid reason before 11 ends have been completed shall be declared void and replayed. In a game terminated after completion of 11 ends but before 15 ends are completed the result shall be that after the last end played. In all situations each skip shall agree to the game being terminated
12. As far as is practicable, if a game has to be postponed for any reason, inform the other Club by 10.00 a.m. of this decision. Postponed games must be played within 2 weeks of the scheduled date.
13. Players must wear Club's official dress when participating in a game associated with the League. Only under exceptional circumstances will this rule be set aside and then only with the agreement of the players involved
14. Score cards - Home Club to retain one set of cards and the other set forwarded to the Match Secretary immediately after the game. Telephone, text or e-mail results are acceptable.
15. All Visiting Club players to contribute £1 towards the Home Club Greenkeeper's gratuity
16. Tea and biscuits to be provided by the Home Club on the arrival of the Visiting team
17. Any burnt end shall not count and shall be replayed in the direction agreed by each skip
18. Where not provided for in the above rules, the rules appearing in the SBA Handbook to apply
19. The league winner each year will host a match as soon as possible after the final game to which one rink from each member club will be invited, after which tea and sandwiches will be provided, the league trophy presented, and any points for discussion raised.
